



## POLICY

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**TOPIC: INTERIM LICENSURE OF NEW GRADUATES**

**DATE: JANUARY 2006**

**REVISED: NEW**

**RESPONSIBILITY: BOARD MEMBERS, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR and REGISTRAR**

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### POLICY

The College will, in certain circumstances, consider issuing a Provisional license prior to actual convocation. This would apply only to individuals who can provide suitable documentation of successful completion of an accredited Physiotherapy educational program and the written portion of the National Exam. Consideration will only be given in such cases where there is considerable delay between course completion and Senate approval for convocation.

### PROVISIONS

Applicants must provide the Registrar with all the appropriate registration documentation including a letter from the educational program Director and the Registrar of the educational Institution confirming graduation status.

The applicant will have twenty-one days from the date of convocation to submit a certified copy of the Degree. Failure to meet this requirement will result in immediate suspension of the member's license to practice.
